

# EAP Checklist

This is the list of items to check you have available before the trip/when boarding the diving vessel. As early as possible check this equipment and ensure people know where it is.

- Emergency oxygen kit
- Pure water, vinegar, acetic acid
- Emergency blanket
- Fire extinguisher

- Gauze/pads
- Bandages/tape
- Scissors, tweezers, needle
